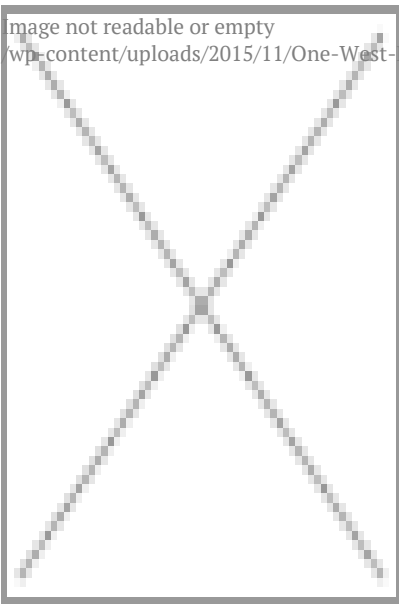


# Bouhan Falligant Associate Recognized with Award
