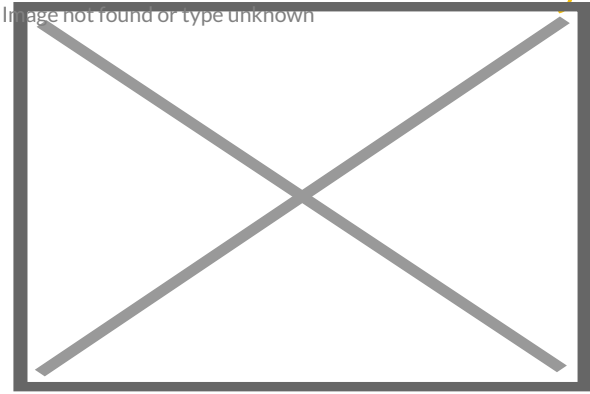


## Bouhan Falligant Hires Ashley Henson as New Attorney
