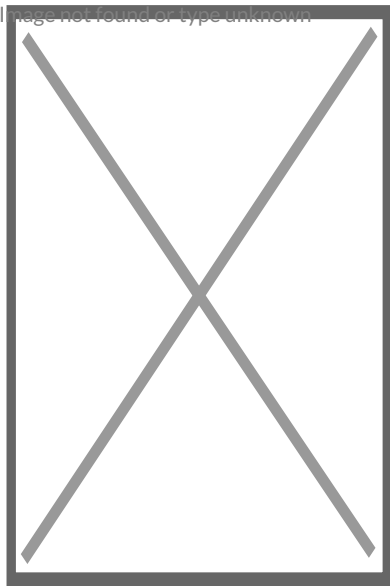


Bouhan Falligant Hires John Harvey as New Attorney
