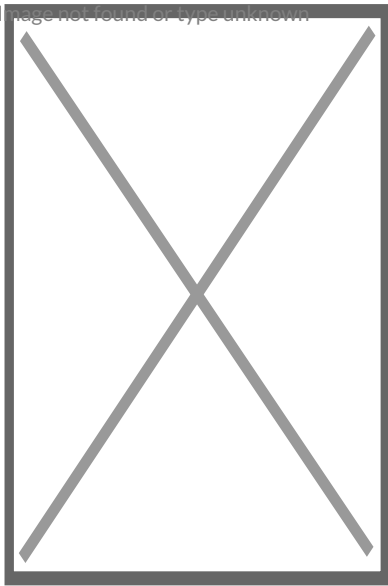


Estate Planning
